Road Construction Set To Begin

The City is preparing to begin its road construction project. This project includes pavement milling, patching, and paving of Daniels Street, Kahler Road (from Water Street to Wildcat Court), and North Water Street. During construction, intermittent lane closures and detours will occur. Residents should anticipate delays and impacts to travel. This work is scheduled to begin on August 7th and is anticipated to last 20 days, weather dependent.

Additionally, Kahler Road (from Butcher Lane to Barr Road) will also be getting rehabilitated. This portion of the project will consist of full-depth pavement milling, regrading, base repairs, and seal coat. This segment of the project will be closed to thru traffic for the duration of construction. The Contractor has requested to begin this work, starting the road closure and detour, on August 7th and is expecting a duration of 45 days to complete the project.



Nuisance Greenery Ordinance



Don't get fined! The City's ordinance code (<u>Chapter 91</u>) limits the height of weeds and grasses to a maximum of eight inches. It also enforces the state of untrimmed trees & shrubs. Enforcement is done on a routine checking basis or in response to a complaint.

Anyone conducting business within the City of Wilmington is required to obtain a business license. This summer the City Council amended the fee schedule based on total square of the business. If your renewal is coming due or you are interested in starting a new business you can reach out to the Deputy City Clerk at (815) 476-2175 for assistance.
