

2023 ROAD RESURFACING PROJECTS UNDERWAY

The City of Wilmington has begun its 2023 road resurfacing project on the following streets:

North Water Street (Rte. 53 to Chicago Streetz) Daniels Street (Rte. 53 to Laurel Avenue) E. Kahler Road (Rte. 102 to Wildcat Court)

During construction, intermittent lane closures and detours will occur. Residents should anticipate delays and impacts to travel. Please be mindful of construction signage and give right of way to workers.

Nuisance Greenery Ordinance Amended

Don't get fined! The City's Nuisance Greenery Ordinance (Chapter 91) limits the height of weeds and grasses to a maximum of eight inches and provides guidelines for enforcement of untrimmed trees & shrubs. Compliance checks are made on a routine basis and in response to complaints. On August 15, 2023, the City Council approved an amendment from the current 30 day grace period for remediation of nuisance greenery violations to 7 days.

Did You Know?

The City of Wilmington maintains and repairs the sewer mains. The sewer main can be defined as the primary pipeline in a sewage system running under the public street or easement that collects wastewater from lateral connections. The sanitary sewer lateral is the pipe that carries your wastewater from your home (toilets, sinks, showers, laundry, floor drains, etc.) to the public sanitary sewer main that is typically in the street. Just like roofs and driveways, maintaining a lateral is the homeowners responsibility.

Often when a resident experiences sewer problems, it is an issue with the sewer lateral — not the sewer main. The most common cause of sewer issues is tree roots infiltrating and blocking flow of the sewer lateral.

Who do I call? If you are experiencing sewer issues, it is a good idea to call Wilmington Public Works at (815) 476-3104. Our Public Works professionals can check the City's sewer mains to determine if the issue you are experiencing is with the City's main or your lateral. If the problem is determined to be stemming from an issue with the sewer lateral, we recommend calling a Licensed Plumber that is certified to work in the City of Wilmington.



Lego Club will meet at 3:30 PM on Monday September 11th, October 16th, and November 6th. Stop in, no registration required. We supply the building blocks.










